

Subject: Enlistment of Teaching and Non-Teaching Personnel For The Tamang Serbisyong Kalusugang Pampamilya (TSEKAP) Program.

Date: 23 September 2015

Last February 17, 2015, the Health and Nutrition Center issued an Unnumbered Memorandum re: Submission of Justification for Low Enlistment Percentage and an Updated Status Report of Personal Enlistment to Preferred Service Providers for the Philhealth Primary Care Benefit 1 (PCB1) Package or TSEKAP Program.

The submitted issues and concerns on the masterlist , validation, and enlistment were brought to the attention of Philhealth and actions were already undertaken by their office.

As the program is on its third year of implementation, it was expected that enlistment of DepEd personnel would be at 100 %. However; as reported by Philhealth, only 66 % of DepEd personnel were enlisted as of July 30, 2015.

In line with this, all school heads are enjoined to fast track the enlistment of all its personnel to their preferred service providers so that they may avail of TSEKAP services. Teachers and non-teaching personnel should be allowed to visit their service provider on a scheduled basis so as not to sacrifice their responsibilities in school. All enlistment form should be submitted to the Division Medical Unit on or before September 23, 2015.
