SUBJECT: NOTICE TO ABIDE BY THE CITY ORDINANCES

DATE: July 22, 2016

The City Mayor's Office recently issued Executive Order No. 20, Series of 2016 entitled "Task Force Disiplina in Dagupan City" which pertains to the City's "efforts to intensify the implementation of the various ordinances that pertain to the regulation of behaviour in the streets in furtherance of the commitment of the City Government to maintain peace and order in the City."

Hence, notice is hereby given to all employees of the Division to abide by the Ordinances being implemented by the City Government of Dagupan. Likewise, school heads and teachers are hereby directed to inform all students about the basic regulations on behaviour which everyone must follow.

In summary, the following are the prohibited acts applicable to our employees and the students:

1. Littering in streets, bay, river, public park, or any other public property (Pagtatapon ng basura sa kalsada, dagat, ilog, parke at iba pang pampublikong lugar);
2. Spitting or discharging of mucus in public (Pagdura sa mga pampublikong lugar);
3. Urinating or defecating in places other than comfort rooms (pag-ihi o pagdumi sa mga lugar bukod sa palikuran);
4. Vandalism;
5. Drinking liquor by a minor (Pag inom ng alak ng isang minorde edad);
6. Neglecting children by allowing them to roam the streets between 10PM and 4AM (Pagpapabaya sa mga bata sa pamamagitan ng pagpahintulot na lumabas sila sa kalsada ng 10PM hanggang 4AM);
7. Smoking in Public (Paninigarilyo sa pampublikong lugar);
8. Noise from any singing activity (Pag-iingay dahil sa pagkanta na nakakaabala sa ibang tao);
9. Drinking liquor in public roads and sidewalks (Pag-inom ng alak sa kalsada at gilid ng kalsada);

10. Allowing stray animals to roam around public roads (Pagpapabaya sa mga alagang hayop na gumala sa kalsada);
11. Permitting minors (students) to play video or computer games during school hours (Pagpahintulot sa mga bata [mag-aaral] na maglaro ng video o computer games kapag oras ng pasukan); and
12. Wandering in public places , roads and streets naked or half-naked (Gumala ng walang saplot ang buong katawan o kalahating bahagi ng katawan).

Commission of any of the said prohibited acts shall be penalized by the City with fines, community service or imprisonment depending on the ordinance violated. Traffic rules must also be observed such as, but not limited to, crossing on pedestrian lanes, driving in one-way streets and parking in designated areas to avoid payment of fines.
