- nurturing hope to improve the educational system of the Philippines.

The search is implemented nationwide and the award will be conferred to five honorees every school year. Honorees should have implemented distinct projects, programs and activities that have benefitted the school children, teachers, schools, the division office and the communities in their respective divisions. Yearly Honorees will be recognized in the Bulwagan ng Karunungan of the Department of Education. These Honorees are recognized and celebrated that they may further inspire and influence others to champion the cause of education in the Philippines thru positive leadership, hardwork and discipline.

### **A. Qualifications for Nomination**

Nominated official must meet the following qualifications:

1. Must be a current Schools Division Superintendent, Schools Division Asst. Superintendent or Division Administrative Officer of the Department of Education.
2. Has rendered at least three years of continuous government service. Accomplishments for which nominee is being recognized for should be made within the last three (3) years immediately prior to nomination. Said accomplishments should have been consistent and continuously carried out by the nominee during the said period;
3. Have a performance rating of at least Very Satisfactory or its equivalent for two (2) annual rating periods prior to the nomination; and
