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



**SUBJECT : REGIONAL SEARCH FOR OUTSTANDING IMPLEMENTERS
OF THE SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM (SBFP)
SY 2017-2018**

DATE : September 15, 2017

1. In compliance with the provisions of DepED Order No. 39, s. 2017, this Office shall conduct a Regional Search for Outstanding School-Based Feeding (SBFP) implementers from September to November 2017.
2. The objectives of this activity are to motivate, recognize, and reward outstanding performance and dedicated SBFP implementers.
3. The Schools Division Office shall form a Schools Division Search Committee who shall evaluate the SBFP implementing schools.
4. The Schools Division Search Committee shall evaluate the schools and shall choose two (2) schools to represent the division. (Except Central Kitchen).
5. The SDS shall nominate the two (2) entry schools to the Regional Director together with the Division Level Evaluation Sheet and school documentation of their implementation.
6. Time Frame

Division selection and submission of schools to represent the division	Division Search Committee	August to October, 2017
Regional Evaluation and awarding of the Outstanding SBFP Implementer	Regional Search Committee	November to December, 2017

7. The Top 3 Regional winners will be awarded during the Regional Awarding in December with the following prizes:
First Prize Php50,000.00, Second Prize Php30,000.00 and Third Prize Php20,000.00.
The Certificates of Recognition will be distributed to all the participating schools.
8. Deadline for the submission of Division Entries will be on October 30, 2017.
9. The Best School Implementer of SBFP may be recognized and awarded on December 2017 based on the following criteria:
 - a. Percentage of beneficiaries rehabilitated to normal nutritional status;
 - b. Compliance with guidelines;
 - c. Prompt submission of liquidation reports;
 - d. Establishment of vegetable gardens;
 - e. Good practices developed and lessons learned;
 - f. Involvement/support of parents and community; and
 - g. Advocacy and social
10. Travel expenses shall be charge to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
