


**Subject :** TRAINING OF SELECTED ATHLETES, COACHES AND TRAINERS  
FOR THE 2018 REGION 1 ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (R1AA) MEET

**Date :** January 4, 2018

1. The 2018 Region I Athletic Association (R1AA) Meet will be hosted by the City of Alaminos and Schools Division Office of Alaminos City. The activity is a fitting culmination of the Physical Education and School Sports Program as embodied in the K to 12 Curriculum and in compliance with the mandate set through Republic Act No. 10588, otherwise known as the Palarong Pambansa Act of 2013 or "An Act Institutionalizing the Palarong Pambansa and Appropriating Funds Therefore."

2. In our desire to prepare our athletes and teams to be more competitive physically and mentally, an intensive training is necessary to make our teams ready and prepared in chasing a dream to sports excellence, thus, the Dagupan City team shall start training immediately in selected venues.

3. The start of training sessions shall be on **JANUARY 5, 2018** at 8:00 o'clock AM in their assigned respective training venues. Training schedule is from **January 5 to February 2, 2018**, whole day.

4. The training shall be supervised and monitored by DCAA officers and Tournament Managers who shall submit a Progress Report every five (5) days during the duration of the training to the Schools Division Superintendent through Dr. Jaime C. Siapno, Division Coordinator in Sports. The Dagupan City Sports Commission (DCSC) is requested to monitor all trainings in the different venues.

5. All athletes shall have their medical-dental check-up and blood typing on scheduled dates that will be announced later.

6. The coaches/school heads shall accompany their athletes in the training venues and will be held responsible for them, likewise, all athletes shall submit their parents' consent before the conduct of the training.

7. All documents needed in the R1AA Meet will be uploaded in the school heads' chat room and shall be prepared on or before January 15, 2018 ready for encoding during the workshop to be held on January 17, 2018 at the Division Training Center.

8. All school heads in consultation with concerned coaches/trainers shall arrange the class schedules/loads/responsibilities of said officials and shall extend all necessary assistance, support and encouragement. In order to meet the challenges of the forthcoming R1AA Meet, the athletes/teams shall be prepared/trained and shall perform their best and this can only be attained with the full support of all school heads, teachers and parents of all delegates from public and private schools.

9. Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the no disruption of classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2015 entitled "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance therewith.

10. Attendance to the R1AA and Palarong Pambansa as official delegates is recognized by the Department, thus, participating athletes **during the duration of the training**, shall be given ample support and that their grades shall not be adversely affected even while they are on travel to represent our Division in these higher meets. Regional Memorandum No. 3, s. 2016 Item No. 3 provides, "School Heads are advised to make the necessary arrangements to ensure that the participating athletes complete their required projects for the fourth grading period. Make-up activities shall be given to participating athletes to compensate the quizzes/tests missed during the competition in order to maintain or increase their ratings per learning area."

11. Please see attached schedule of training and final list of athletes/coaches/trainers/chaperons and monitoring officials for your reference.

12. Immediate and wide dissemination of and strict compliance to this memorandum is desired.
