






Registration fee shall be charged against SPG/SSG funds and donations/solicitations from benevolent stakeholders.
4. All SSG/SPG teacher-adviser participants are eligible for the grant of service credit pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003. Enclosed is the Parental Consent to be signed by parents/guardians of participating pupils and students.


