



Greetings!

On **August 17, 2019**, 15,000 young leaders from Philippines and abroad will convene at the **SM Mall of Asia Arena** for the annual Global Youth Summit (GYS). GYS, one of the largest gathering of youth in the world, is co-organized by Global Peace Foundation and SM Cares with the following objectives: a) create a space for young people ages 14 to 35 to share their ideas and utilize their diverse skills, knowledge, and networks to effectively address persistent problems of today; b) raise awareness on youth's role in advancing sustainable development; and c) encourage youth to participate and contribute to achieving the targets of United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by 2030. In addition, the Visayas leg will be held on August 24, 2019 at SMX in Cebu. Participation for both events is free.

On its 7th year, GYS will also award five innovative youth ideas that can be implemented in Filipino communities to advance this year's topics: inclusive education, youth-responsive health services, creating youth-enabling employment and self-employment ecosystems, civic awareness and participation, and creating safe spaces and reducing all forms of violence against children. These targets are aligned to the priority areas of the UN Youth Strategy for Sustainable Development launched in September 2018.

In line with this we would like to request your assistance to endorse the event and nominate student and youth leaders from the student councils, local youth organizations, and National Service Training Program (NSTP) as delegates for this summit to experience best learning with international exposure. We would also like to request your school/ organization to excuse them from their classes/ duties for the said date of the event. Moreover, delegates are encouraged to participate in the #GlobalYouth4SDGs Seed Grant Competition and submit their entries before July 13 for a chance to be one of the top 5 awardees of a Php200,000 seed grant for a sustainable project idea. One team can submit multiple entries to the competition.







SEED GRANT COMPETITION 2019

As critical thinkers, innovators, and active drivers of change in local communities, the overall success of the SDGs depends on the engagement of youth.

As a youth development platform aligned with the achievement of SDGs, GYS is inviting youth leaders to design, develop, and deliver creative and innovative ideas that will address issues related to the theme. Through the seed grant competition, Global Youth Summit 2019 aims to promote youth's engagement in contributing to the 2030 Agenda through youth-led long-term solutions to real-life problems and challenges in the 21st Century.

Teams for the Top 5 entries for each theme will be invited for a final deliberation with a set of judges from GPF, SM Cares, and partner organizations on August 10 (venue will be announced). The contest winners will be awarded on August 17 at Mall of Asia Arena during the Global Youth Summit 2019. They will be provided with the resources to implement the project for 1-year. The impact and assessment of the projects will be documented and presented on the next Global Youth Summit.

WHO CAN JOIN?

- The contest is open to all youth ages 14 to 35 years of age
- They should form a group with 3 to 5 members.
- Each group shall submit a concept paper with a proposed sustainable project which can be implemented in communities in the Philippines.
- The project should be able to address one of the following themes aligned to the priority areas of the UN Youth Strategy for Sustainable Development launched in September 2018:
