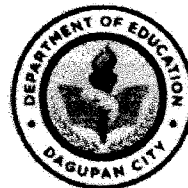

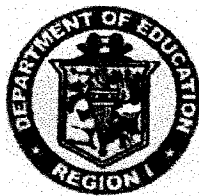

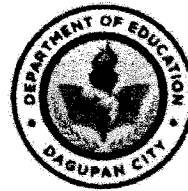
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IT OFFICE

1. In compliance with the provision of DM 223 s. 2016 "Strengthening the Implementation of the Gulayan sa Paaralan Program (GPP) in Public Elementary and Secondary Schools Nationwide, this Office shall conduct a Division Search for outstanding Gulayan sa Paaralan Program Implementation from October 2019 to February 2020.
2. The objectives of this activity are to motivate, to recognize, and to reward outstanding performance and dedicated GPP implementers.
3. The Schools Division Search Committee shall evaluate the GPP implementing schools and shall choose Top Three (3) per category for GPP Best Implementer.

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5. The Best School Implementer of GPP will be recognized and awarded on February 2020 based on the following criteria.

Gulayan sa Paaralan Program (GPP)

- a. Crop Integration –20%
 - Refers to productive fruits, vegetables, root indigenous plant materials or Indigenous herbal plants.
 - b. Crop Production System – 25%
 - Use of container vegetables artistry, gardening production and management.
 - Crop Museum
 - c. Product Utilization – 20%
 - % nutritional problematic school children supported maintained under the Gulayan sa Paaralan program.
 - d. Sustainability – 15%
 - Presence of sustainability plan (document), nurseries and stakeholders.
 - e. Land Resource Space Utilization – 10%
 - % utilization of school area suitable for gardening
 - f. PLUS FACTOR – 10%
 - Use of edible landscape
6. To give recognition to the Best Implementers of GPP, incentives and certificate of recognition will be given.
7. All school heads are enjoined to provide full administrative support to the management of the program.
