Camp Fee: P 200.00 for all the campers inclusive of event scarf and badges


P50.00 for Twinklers and Star Scouts

## Things to Bring:

### Campers

1. GSP Official Uniform
2. Camp Uniform (GSP T-shirts, Maong Pants/ Jogging Pants, Bermuda Shorts, )
3. Health Form and Parent's Permit
4. Plain White t-shirt
5. Personal Effects and toiletries
6. Pajama, Jogging Pants, Sweater, Rain Coat
7. Bed roll/beddings/tents
8. Flashlight and 1 small candle
9. First Aid Kit, mosquito repellent
10. Garbage Bag
11. Art Materials
12. Sit-upon
13. Campfire attire
14. Slippers, rubber shoes
15. White tshirt for printing

### Patrols

1. Tents, bamboos, ropes, water containers, electrical needs
2. Brooms, garbage container
3. Patrol Bulletin Board
4. Cooking paraphernalia
5. Food Provisions for 3 days

### CAMP RULES:

1. Patrol System must be used in all aspects of managing the camp.
2. Have a buddy wherever you go
3. Be prompt in all activities
4. Proper uniform and attire shall be worn at all times
5. Help maintain the orderliness and cleanliness/ sanitation of the campsite
6. Help conserve energy like water and electricity.
7. Use camp facilities properly
8. Be responsible to your own belongings and valuables. The camp management will not be responsible of any lost items
9. There should be no unnecessary running in camp.
10. There should be absolute SILENCE during rest period or TAPS
11. Going outside the campsite without a Tita /troop leader is strictly prohibited
12. Be aware of the Contingency Plan, in case of emergency
13. REMEMBER... be Friendly, Smile and enjoy the camp.
