


**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS: SECURITY BANK FOUNDATION, INC.
MENTORING FUTURE LEADERS PROGRAM**

1. The Security Bank Foundation, Inc. (SBFI) is offering 30 training slots for Principals of its beneficiary schools for the 2nd run of its Mentoring Future Leaders for Nation-Building program. This 3-year training program, in partnership with the Ateneo Center of Educational Development, encompasses the international Certificate in Educational Studies in Leadership (CESL) modules developed by the University of Bristol (UoB), United Kingdom, and funded by The HEAD Foundation Singapore. SBFI will cover all expenses for travel, accommodations, and meals for the two in-person training sessions, each spanning four days.
2. The concerned Schools Divisions are requested to disseminate this memorandum to the covered schools with SBFI buildings to encourage qualified principals to apply for the program on or before May 3, 2024. A list of partner schools is attached per Annex A.
3. Interested applicants should meet the following criteria:
 - a. Have at least 7 years of service before retirement.
 - b. Be available and able to commit to attending all in-person and online activities for three years.
 - c. Demonstrate resourcefulness in implementing context-based school transformation.
4. Should principals from beneficiary schools not meet the eligibility requirements, the Division may recommend qualified principals from other schools, preferably foreseen as successor principals of SBFI partner schools.
5. Online application forms and further details are available at securitybank.com/mentoring-future-leaders. Key program details are provided in Annex B.
6. The tentative schedule for the in-person training sessions is July 8-12, 2024, and October 21-25, 2024, at Ateneo de Cebu, Mandaue City, Cebu. These dates are subject to change pending completion of documentation agreements with the UoB. Accepted applicants will be notified of final dates upon execution of our MOU with UoB.

7. Given the limited availability of 30 slots for the program and the high demand with 113 school principals vying for these slots, it is strongly encouraged that principals submit their complete applications well in advance of the deadline on May 3, 2024.

8. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is requested.



Security Bank Foundation, Inc. (SBFI) is offering 30 training slots for Principals of its beneficiary schools for the 2nd run of its Mentoring Future Leaders for Nation-Building. The course is a 3-year training program in partnership with the Ateneo Center of Educational Development. It includes the international Certificate in Educational Studies in Leadership (CESL) modules developed by University of Bristol (UoB) United Kingdom and funded by The HEAD Foundation Singapore. SBFI will shoulder all expenses on travel, accommodations and meals for the 2 in-person training sessions (4 days each).

This is to request your Office to circulate a memorandum to the covered DepEd Divisions of SBFI to encourage qualified principals from schools with SBFI buildings to apply for the program on or before May 3, 2024. A list of partner schools is attached per Annex A.


Interested applicants should (1) have at least 7 years of service before retirement, (2) be available and can commit to attend all in-person and online activities for three years, and (3) has demonstrated resourcefulness in implementing context-based school transformation. Should principals from beneficiary schools not meet the eligibility requirements, the Division may recommend qualified principals from other schools preferably foreseen as successor principals of the partner schools of SBFI.

Online application form and other details may be accessed at securitybank.com/mentoring-future-leaders. Key details of the program are in Annex B.

The in-person training sessions are tentatively scheduled on July 8-12, 2024 and October 21-25 at Ateneo de Cebu, Mandaue City, Cebu. The session schedules are tentative at this point as we await completion of documentation agreements with the UoB. Accepted applicants will be informed of final dates upon execution of our MOU with UoB.

As only 30 slots are open, versus the 113 school principals vying for the slots, we encourage principals to submit their complete applications much earlier than May 3, 2024.
