#### Advocacy Video Contest Guidelines

##### 1. Contest Overview

As part of the 2025 Children’s Summit, Junior High School students are invited to express their creativity and advocacy through short videos that promote the importance of caring and sharing for a healthy body and mind.

This contest aims to empower young people to become advocates for physical and mental well-being in their schools and communities.

##### 2. Eligibility

- Open to Junior High School students (Grades 7 to 10).
- Participants may join individually or as a group (maximum of 5 members per group).
- Each individual or group is allowed to submit only one (1) entry.
- Participants must be currently enrolled in the 2025–2026 school year.

##### 3. Video Content Guidelines

The advocacy video should reflect the **theme**: Participants are encouraged to creatively highlight any of the following:

- Promoting healthy habits such as proper hygiene, balanced diet, exercise, and good sleep.
- Raising awareness on mental health and emotional well-being.
- Acts of kindness, sharing, and community support that inspire others.
- Encouraging children and youth to take part in creating a healthier, more caring environment.

##### Additional Content Rules:

- Language: English or Filipino (with English subtitles if using another language).
- Content must be child-friendly, original, and free of offensive language or imagery.

- Plagiarism or the use of copyrighted materials without permission will result in automatic disqualification.

- Resolution: Minimum 720p (HD)

**Sandwich Making Contest Guidelines**

**1. Contest Overview**

As part of the 2025 Children’s Summit celebration, a Sandwich Making Contest will be held to encourage healthy eating habits, promote family involvement, and provide a fun, hands-on learning experience for Kindergarten learners.

This contest will feature a Mother-and-Child Tandem, where each participating child will work together with their mother (or guardian) to create a healthy and creative sandwich using sponsored ingredients. This activity aims to highlight the importance of parental participation in nurturing healthy habits at home.

**2. Eligibility and Participation**

- Open to Kindergarten students from both Public and Private Schools.
- Public Schools: 1 representative per district.
- Private Schools: A total of 8 participating schools.
- Each participating school must be represented by:
  - 1 Kindergarten student and her /his legal mother.
- Each tandem must bring their own utensils, plates, and preparation tools. Working tables will be provided by the organizers.
- All ingredients will be provided by the sponsoring company on the day of the contest.

**3. Contest Mechanics**

1. Each Mother-and-Child Tandem will prepare one (1) sandwich using only the provided ingredients.
2. Ingredients will consist of a variety of healthy options, such as:
  - Breads: whole wheat, white, or multigrain
  - Fruits and vegetables: lettuce, tomato, cucumber, banana, etc.
  - Protein sources: ham, egg, tuna, chicken, etc.
  - Cheese and spreads: mayonnaise, sandwich spread, etc.
3. Pre-cooking is allowed (e.g., boiling eggs), but actual sandwich assembly must be done on-site during the contest.
4. Mothers may assist their child in safe tasks, but the child must actively participate in preparing and decorating the sandwich.

5. Participants are encouraged to decorate and present their sandwich in a fun and creative way.
6. Preparation Time: 20 minutes.
7. After preparation, the sandwich will be presented to the judges for evaluation.

#### 4. Judging Criteria

- Strictly **no sharp or dangerous tools** for children. Mothers may assist as needed for safety.
- Tandems are responsible for **keeping their work area clean** and must clean up after the activity.

## 1. Contest Overview

As part of the 2025 Children’s Summit celebration, the Bulilit Pop Idol Singing Contest aims to discover and showcase the musical talents of Grade 2 pupils from both public and private schools.

This event promotes confidence, self-expression, and appreciation of Filipino music and artistry among young learners in a fun and supportive environment.

## 2. Eligibility and Participation

- Open to Grade 2 pupils from both Public and Private Schools.
- Public Schools: 1 representative per district (8 districts)
- Private Schools: A total of 8 participating schools.
- Each school is allowed only one (1) official contestant.
- Contestants must be currently enrolled in Grade 2 for School Year 2025–2026.
- A coach, parent, or guardian may accompany the contestant for support.

## 3. Contest Mechanics

1. Each contestant will perform one (1) song of their choice.
2. The chosen song must be child-appropriate, either:
  - Original Pilipino Music (OPM) or
  - Any other suitable song with wholesome lyrics.
3. Contestants may sing a cappella, with minus-one (instrumental), or with simple live accompaniment (to be arranged by the school).
4. Performance time limit: 4 minutes maximum.

5. Contestants must provide their minus-one (instrumental) in MP3 format (on USB or emailed in advance to the organizers).
6. Simple costumes and props are allowed but should not distract from the performance.
7. Order of performances will be determined through drawing of lots before the contest.

#### 4. Judging Criteria

Interpretation & Expression	20%
Diction & Timing	10%
Overall Impact	5%

- Only wholesome and age-appropriate songs are allowed. Songs with inappropriate lyrics or themes will lead to disqualification.
- Contestants are encouraged to wear simple, neat costumes suitable for their performance.
- Schools are responsible for ensuring their contestants' minus-one is ready and properly labeled.
- Microphones and sound system will be provided by the organizers.

**Spelling Bee Guidelines**

November 12, 2025 (Wednesday) | 1:30 PM

**1. Contest Overview**

The Spelling Bee is one of the highlight academic activities of the 2025 Children’s Summit, designed to develop Grade 3 pupils’ spelling proficiency, vocabulary, and listening skills.

**2. Eligibility and Participation**

- A. Open to Grade 3 pupils from both Public and Private Schools.
  - Public Schools: 1 representative per district, a total of 8 participants.
  - Private Schools: A total of 8 participating schools.
  - Each district/ school is allowed only one (1) official contestant.
- B. Contestants must be officially enrolled in Grade 3 for School Year 2025–2026.
- C. A coach, parent, or guardian may accompany the contestant for support.

**3. Contest Mechanics**

1. The contest will be conducted in written format using official answer sheets provided by the organizers.
2. The spelling master will:
  - Say each word twice,
  - Use it in a sentence, and
  - Repeat the word.
  - Say GO..
3. Contestants are given 20 seconds (easy round) , 30 seconds (average round) and 40 seconds (difficult round) per word to write their answer.
4. Words are categorized into three (3) levels of difficulty with corresponding points as follows;

Round	No. of Words	Points per Word	Total Points
Easy Round	10 words	1 point each	10 points
Average Round	10 words	3 points each	30 points
Difficult Round	5 words	5 points each	25 points

Total Highest Possible Score: 65 points

5. Contestants must write their answers clearly and legibly. Unclear or ambiguous answers may be marked incorrect.
6. Once time is called for a word, no changes are allowed on the answer sheet.
7. After each word, answer sheets will be raised and checked by the Board of Judges.
8. Winners will be determined based on the total scores obtained from all three rounds.
9. In case of a tie, a written sudden-death round with more challenging words will be conducted until a winner emerges.

*The decision of the panel of judges is final and irrevocable.*

- No coaching or prompting will be allowed during the contest.

**Nutri-Cook Fest Guidelines**

### 1. Contest Overview

The Nutri-Cook Fest is one of the featured activities of the 2025 Children’s Summit, designed to promote healthy eating habits, family involvement, and culinary creativity among learners.

This year’s contest will feature a Father-and-Son Tandem, highlighting the importance of male involvement in promoting good nutrition at home. Each tandem will prepare a nutritious and creative dish that reflects the theme of health and family teamwork.

### 2. Eligibility and Participation

- Open to Grade 5 or Grade 6 students from both Public and Private Schools.
- Public Schools: 1 Father-and-Son Tandem per district.
- Private Schools: A total of 8 participating schools.
- Each team must consist of:
  - 1 Grade 5 or 6 student (the legal son), and
  - 1 father (biological, legal guardian,).
- Each school may send only one (1) tandem.
- Participants must bring their own cooking utensils, equipment, and table setup.

### 3. Contest Mechanics

1. Each tandem will prepare one (1) complete nutritious dish within the given time.
2. The dish may be a main course, snack, or creative healthy meal suitable for children.
3. All ingredients will be provided by the sponsoring company, except for fish, meat, or poultry, which participants must bring on their own.
4. Participants may bring a small amount of additional ingredients for garnishing or presentation, subject to the approval of the contest committee.
5. Each tandem must:
  - Cook and prepare the dish on-site,
  - Present the finished dish attractively on a plate or tray, and
  - Submit the recipe sheet indicating ingredients and preparation steps.
6. Preparation and cooking time: 1 hour.

7. Both father and son must actively participate in the preparation — teamwork will be observed.
8. Safe food handling and cleanliness must be observed at all times.
9. After cooking, tandems will present their dish to the panel of judges for evaluation.

#### 4. Judging Criteria

<b>Presentation and Creativity</b>	20%
<b>Teamwork (Father &amp; Son Participation)</b>	15%

#### 5. Awards and Recognition

- Champion – Certificate + Prize

All tandems will receive Certificates of Participation.

#### 6. Important Notes

- Participants must arrive at least 30 minutes before the contest starts.
- All cooking must be done on-site; pre-cooking is allowed only for ingredients that require extended preparation (e.g., boiling meat), but final cooking and assembly must be done during the contest.
- Tandems must bring their own portable stoves, utensils, chopping boards, pots/pans, and other cooking materials.
- All ingredients and working tables will be provided by the sponsoring company, except for fish, meat, or poultry, which must be brought by the participants.
- Any additional ingredients for garnishing or special presentation must be declared and approved.
- Teams must clean their work area after the contest.
- Coordinated aprons, caps, or simple uniforms are encouraged for presentation.

**1. Contest Overview**

The Poem Recitation Contest is one of the highlight activities of the 2025 Children’s Summit, designed to develop language skills, self-confidence, artistic expression, and a love for literature among Grade 1 pupils.

This contest aims to give young learners the opportunity to express emotions, demonstrate clear speech, and build confidence through public performance.

**2. Eligibility and Participation**

- Open to Grade 1 pupils from both Public and Private Schools.
- Public Schools: 1 contestant per district.
- Private Schools: A total of 8 participating schools.
- Each district/school is allowed with only one (1) official contestant and must present his/her school ID or certification from the school head.

**1. Objectives of the Contest**

The Cha Cha Cha Dance Contest aims to highlight the importance of physical activity, teacher-student collaboration, and artistic expression through ballroom dancing

**2. Eligibility and Participation**

- Open to Grade 6 learners from Public and Private Schools.
- Public Schools: 1 contestant per district (8 Districts)
